

OPENING UP PROCEDURE

In order that we (the Golf Club Council) ensure that the Golf Club opens up safely, after restrictions have been lifted, a sensible approach has to be undertaken to ensure that the golf course is ready, and the golfers are safe.

In order to achieve this Oldmeldrum Golf Club will be opened in three phases as follows:

Phase 1: Golf Course, Driving Range, Pro Shop, Changing Rooms.

Phase 2: Admin Office, Kitchen (Snacks Only), Bar, Club House

Phase 3: Full Club House facilities (Kitchen & Bar)

Phases will be at least 1 week apart (depending on the situation at the time) and at each phase, personnel will require to be notified in advance prior to the opening day to ensure all areas are ready.

The Template below gives an outline to the areas, personnel and time required to open.

NOTE: All the following will be in line with government guidelines/restrictions imposed upon the lockdown being lifted. **REMEMBER**, although the lockdown has been partially lifted, COVID-19 is still with us and social distancing (minimum 2m apart), washing hands etc. **MUST** be adhered too. This also means the gathering of golfers in the car park and outside and inside the Professional Golf Shop.

PLEASE REMEMBER, these opening procedures will only work if ALL members adhere to them.

		 Note to ALL members (Via email / Newsletter that all playing Golfers must book a Tee Time through BRS, this will assist in golf course participation and insurance. 	
		• Only ONE person allowed in the Admin Office at any one time.	

NOTE:

There will be no access to the Club House via the changing rooms.

Safety Signs will be placed at the entrance and around the practice green to remind golfers of Oldmeldrum Golf Club RULES.
