RESPONSIBILITY

Everyone in the club, including members, parents, volunteers, staff, visitors as well as council members, is responsible for the wellbeing and protection junior members and visitors under 18 years old.

Respond

- •Respond calmly.
- Reassure the young person they have done right to ask for help.
- Don't make promises you cannot keep.
- Take action to ensure the immediate safety of the young person if required.

Report

- •Report to the club's Safeguarding Officer or, in their absence, the statutory agencies.
- •Follow guidelines and protocols (found on the club's website).
- Share information appropriately **Do not share wider than necessary.**

Record

- Record and date the information you have gathered.
- •Share information with the club's Safeguarding Officer or, in their absence the statutory agencies.
- •Support the young person, and record their word.
